## **Traffic Control Plan**

Tour de Madison - Saturday May 16, 2020

**Purpose:** The purpose of this plan is to outline the effects of a bicycle ride on traffic around Madison County on May 16, 2020

#### I. Overview

The 33rd annual Tour de Madison cycling event will be held on Saturday, May 16, 2020 from 8:30am to 3:00pm.

There will be three routes all starting and ending at Graves Mountain Lodge in Syria, Va. A Family Ride (20 Miles); an Intermediate Ride (42 miles); and a Metric Century (66 Miles).

Traffic flow will not be modified for the Tour de Madison.

Approximately 400 cyclists will be participating in the bike ride.

#### II. Bike Course

- This will be a three-loop bike course with all routes beginning and ending at Graves Mountain Lodge, Syria, VA. Metric Century cyclists will start at 8:30am, Intermediate Route cyclists will start at 8:45am. Family Route cyclists will start at 9:00 am. The first cyclist should be returning at approximately 10:30 AM (Family Riders), 11:00AM (Intermediate Route), and 12:30PM (Metric Century). THE LAST CYCLIST SHOULD FINISH BY 3:00 PM.
- Signage will be stationed on the course at appropriate intersections through the courses. (See IV. Below)
- Madison County Deputies will alert traffic on 231 between 670 (Old Blue Ridge Turnpike) and 609 (Hoover Road) between 8:30 and 9:15 am as Metric Century and Forty-Five Mile riders cover the half-mile on Rt. 231.
- Madison County Deputies will alert traffic on 638 (Hebron Church Rd.) between 673 (Cedar Hill Rd) between 8:45 and 10:00 am as Metric Century and Forty-Five Mile riders cover the mile on Rt. 231.

#### III. Traffic Flow Plan:

- 1. From 8:30-9:15 AM the intersection of 670 and 231 and at the intersection of 231 & 609 will be monitored by police officers (**Madison County Sheriff**).
- 2. From 8:45 to 10:00am police offers in vehicles will alert traffic on Rt. to cyclists entering that road from 638 Hebron Church Road and proceeding up the hill into the town of Madison.
- 3. Rest stops at Graves Mtn. Lodge (Syria), Hoover Ridge Park (Madison) Good Hope Baptist Church (Radiant), and, Hebron Lutheran Church will be staffed by volunteers and personnel from Madison County Parks and Recreation will be patrolling the route between the various rest stops.
- 4. "Bike Event" and "Special Event" signage will be removed immediately following the last cyclist.

#### IV. Static Signs

All static signs are to be placed before the ride on Saturday morning, May 16, and removed following the ride.



- I. Two on Southbound 29 at 722 Fishback Rd.
- J. Two on Northbound 29 at 722 Fishback Rd
- K. On Main Street Madison for northbound traffic before Fairground Rd
- L. On Main Street Madison for southbound traffic before 231/Blue Ridge Turnpike
- M. On 230 Orange Rd for eastbound traffic before 616 Carpenters Mill Rd.
- N. On 230 Orange Rd for westbound traffic before 607 Elly Rd.


